

VI. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Candidates should bring the following original records when they present themselves for interview:
 - a) Transfer certificate from the institution last attended
 - b) Colour xerox copies of PUC & SSLC Marks Card.
 - c) Conduct Certificate from the institution last attended
 - d) Two recent passport size photos.
 - e) Xerox copy of Adhar card and Voter Id.
 - f) Income Declaration Certificate
(in the case of students seeking fee concession)
 - g) Caste Certificate (SC/ST/BT/OBC)
(in case student claims seat under the category)
 - h) Migration Certificate
(in the case of students coming from outside the state of Karnataka)
2. If admitted, the students must be prepared to follow the rules and regulations of the Institution as given in the College Calendar and as imposed by the college authorities from time to time.
3. All admissions to the College are provisional and subject to the approval of the Mangalore University.
4. A Student who withdraws after completing his/her admission, shall forfeit the fees paid by him or her.
5. If admitted to the college he/she will have to pay the prescribed fees.

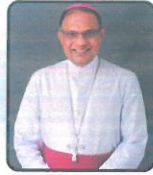
Introduction :

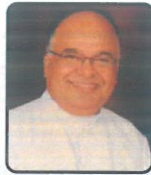
Catholic Board of Education (CBE)
